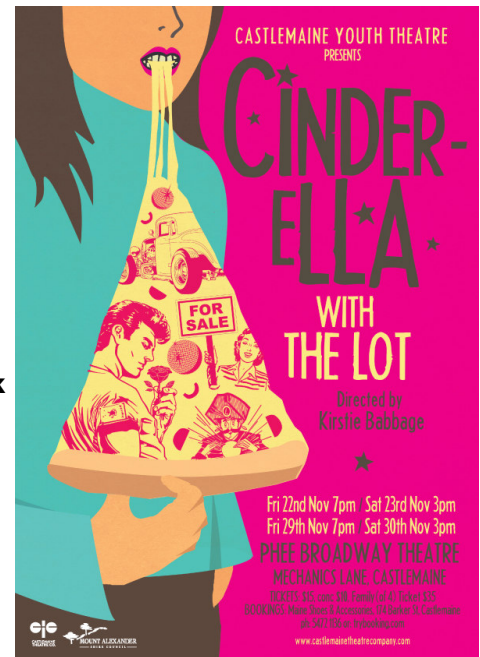


TICKETS ON SALE NOW for CINDERELLA WITH THE LOT! - A Modern Day Fairytale

Cinderella with The Lot will be the third production created by the Castlemaine Youth Theatre. Director, Kirstie Babbage, has been facilitator of the CYT for the past 2 years and has been creating devised theatre works as an actor and director with children and young people for 20 years. "The process of creating a

show like this is a lot of fun! Our group meets weekly and experiments with games, improvisations and physical characterisations. The characters and storylines are woven together, as ideas build on ideas," Kirstie says, "You never quite know what will happen next or where you will end up. Someone will say 'what if that Cinderella was a Goth or she was really clumsy, what if the Fairy Godmother was deaf? What would happen then?' So we just try it out until we find something that fits with the vision we have for the play, the end result is an incredibly funny show that has been created equally by everyone involved. This is a unique style of theatre and such a creative and talented group of young people, I feel lucky to be a part of it."

The CTC's existing constitution was created in 2004, based on the old Model Rules, with a few changes. So our existing constitution is nearly ten years old. We want to give members of the CTC the opportunity to be involved in this process, so we are having a Special General Meeting on Tuesday 19 November to give everyone the opportunity to find out what is happening. If you want to attend the meeting you will need to be a financial member of the CTC. All financial members have already received an email notification of the meeting, so if this is the first you've heard about it, and you want to come along, you'll need to renew your membership. This will cost you \$10 and will only last through till the next AGM in March.
